Overview

Using the mathematical operations on your lifeguard cards, remove as many dice as possible from the pool. There are bonus snacks for those who get out quick. But there are always a few stragglers who cause problems. Work together to clear all the dice four times and you win!

Components

- 10 dice
- Pool and deck built into the box
- 29 lifeguard cards
- 8 treat cards
- 1 lifeguard chair
- 1 snack bar
- 1 clock with hour hand

How To Play



Roll all dice into the pool. Players act as lifeguards and must attempt to clear the pool of dice (swimmers).



Each lifeguard card contains a mathematical operation and a total. Combine multiple dice using the operation to reach the required total.



As you remove dice, place them on the deck chairs around the pool. When a section is full, take a snack bar card - used to modify dice on future turns.



Players must clear the pool four times without running out of lifeguard cards. If they do, they win! If not, they lose!
